Essential Job Duties:				
Reviews and evaluates physician's referral/prescription and patient's medical records to determine physical therapy treatment required. Performs patient tests, measurements, and evaluations, such as range of motion and manual muscle tests, gait, and functional analysis and body parts measurements, and records and evaluates findings to aid in establishing or revising specifics of treatment programs. Plans and prepares written treatment program based on evaluation of available patient data. Records patient treatment, response and progress. Instructs, motivates, and assists patients in non-manual exercises, such as active regimens, isometric and progressive-resistive and in functional activities, such as ambulation, transfer and daily living activities, using weights, pulleys, exercise machines, mats, steps and inclined surfaces, and assistive and supportive devices. Other duties as required.				
Qualifications:	Must have a B.S. or M.S. degree from an accredited physical therapy school. Current Washington state physical therapy license. BLS and ACLS required. Ability to communicate clearly and effectively, delegate and coordinate through leadership skills. Ability to communicate with people of diverse backgrounds and educational levels; i.e. patients, families, employees, physicians, etc. Bilingual Spanish skills helpful, but not required.
