	shielding devices, and practices appropriate radiation protection procedures. May specialize in acquiring x-rays								
	and CT of specific areas of the body. Files, reports, and maintains records of service rendered. Helps maintain the care, inventory, and use of supplies and equipment throughout the Radiology Department and hospital.								
	Participates in annual inventory and other administrative duties. Other duties as assigned.								
	CT Tech: Responsible for the care and safety of patients undergoing treatment and use of equipment to minimize								
	hazards of electric shock, burns, and extraneous radiation. Determines most suitable anatomical posture,								
	positions, and shields patients accordingly. Practices medical and surgical aseptic procedures. Assesses, evaluates,								
	and informs physician of changes in patient's condition. Works under the direction of a Radiologist. Performs all								
	quality control checks, as prescribed.								
	Maintains accurate QC logs, service records, etc. Performs highest quality of imaging that is consistent with the								
	prescribed examination, documents, and deviation. Understands contraindications and potential hazards of								
	different exams.
