Also provides professional nursing care to acutely ill, convalescing, and chronically ill patients in support of care as directed by the Medical Staff, as well as supervising the bedside care of nursing assistants assigned to work with these patients.

Essential Job Duties:

Provides safe and effective nursing care to the obstetrical patient and baby; on admission and during the labor and delivery experience. Assist with the initiation and maintenance of accurate and concise nursing records and reports. Communicates in a timely fashion with the physician in regards to maternal and fetal status. Identifies nursing service problems and assists in their resolutions. Participates in activities to track quality of patient care and its conformance to recognized standards for nursing services. Promotes professional behavior in self and others. Assesses patients and perform patient care responsibilities considering needs specific to the standard of care for patient's age and diagnosis. Enter patient information into EMR system. Communicate with Providers, Charge Nurse and care team members, as appropriate, regarding changes in patient's clinical condition including results of diagnostic studies and symptomology. Respond quickly and accurately to changes in patient condition or response to treatment. Perform general nursing duties in all departments with adequate supervision.
