Position Summary:	Registered nurses (RNs) work to promote good health and prevent illness. Provides professional nursing care to acutely ill, convalescing, and chronically ill patients as directed by the medical staff. Many registered nurses are Medical Surgical nurses who focus on the overall care of patients. They administer medications under the supervision of doctors and keep records of symptoms and progress. Medical Surgical nurses also supervise licensed practical nurses (LPNs), nurses' aides (CNAs), and nursing students.				
Essential Job Duties:	Assesses patients and performs patient care responsibilities considering needs specific to the standard of care for patient's age and diagnosis. Communicates with Providers, Charge Nurses, and care team members as appropriate, regarding changes in patient's clinical condition including results of diagnostic studies and symptomology. Responds quickly and accurately to changes in patient condition or response to treatment. Performs general nursing duties in all departments with adequate supervision. Follows the Five Medication Rights to help reduce the potential for med errors. Formulates a patient teaching plan based upon identified learning needs and evaluate effectiveness of learning; family or caretaker is included in teaching as appropriate. Interacts with patients, families, co-workers, and Providers with respect, dignity, and empathy. Identifies and addresses psychosocial, cultural, ethnic, and religious/spiritual needs of patients and their families or caretakers. Demonstrates knowledge of the principles of growth and development over the life span and the skills necessary to provide age-appropriate care to the patient population served. Documents patient care according to standards and policies. Participates in and supports orientation of personnel and all available in-services. Other duties as assigned.
