Perform preventive maintenance on scheduled basis on assigned equipment for compliance. Handle all work orders received by Maintenance and other duty assignments in a professional manner. Perform safety checks and recommend course of action. Assist with security situations as needed. Relieve or assist other service departments in the discharge of their duties.
