Helps maintain the care, inventory, and use of supplies and equipment throughout the Radiology Department and hospital. Participates in annual inventory and other administrative duties.</p> <p>Mammo Tech: Assists patients through the stressful mammogram process while using low-dose X-ray imaging equipment to view the breast. Being conscientious and able to follow instructions is important to avoid making errors during the test. Ability to work with and maintain the mammography machine. Technical expertise when using medical equipment. Other duties may include processing confidential patient records, as well as consulting with physicians and surgeons. Maintain accurate QC logs, service records, etc. Performs highest quality of imaging that is consistent with the prescribed examination, documents, and deviation.
