Enter patient information into EMR system. Communicate with Providers, Charge Nurse, and care team members, as appropriate, regarding changes in patient's clinical condition, including results of diagnostic studies and symptomatology. Respond quickly and accurately to changes in patient condition or response to treatment. Perform general nursing duties in all departments with adequate supervision.</p> <p><u>ER:</u> The most important responsibility for an emergency nurse is understanding triage, which is a method of prioritizing injuries based on medical need. An emergency nurse must have the ability to make quick and accurate assessments about incoming patients, including both physical and mental health conditions. Provides safe and effective nursing care to the emergency room patient and/or outpatient. Provides or assists with the initiation and maintenance of accurate concise outpatient records. Communicates in a timely fashion pertinent assessment to the Providers and carries out orders. Other duties as assigned.</p> | | | | |
