Position Summary:	<p><u>Med-Surg:</u> Provides professional nursing care to acutely ill, convalescing, and chronically ill patients in support of care as directed by the Medical Staff, as well as supervising the bedside care of nursing assistants assigned to work with these patients.</p> <p><u>ER:</u> Provides professional nursing care for assigned patients in the Emergency Room. Triage each patient and determines priority of care based on physical, psychological, and social needs as well as factors influencing patient flow through the emergency care system.</p>				
Essential Job Duties:	<p><u>Med-Surg:</u> Assess patients and perform patient care responsibilities considering needs specific to the standard of care for patient's age and diagnosis. Enter patient information into EMR system. Communicate with providers, charge nurse, and care team members, as appropriate, regarding changes in patient's clinical condition including results of diagnostic studies and symptomology. Respond quickly and accurately to changes in patient condition or response to treatment. Perform general nursing duties in all departments with adequate supervision.</p> <p><u>ER:</u> The most important responsibility for an emergency nurse is understanding triage, which is a method of prioritizing injuries based on medical need. An emergency nurse must have the ability to make quick and accurate assessments about incoming patients, including both physical and mental health conditions. Provide safe and effective nursing care to the emergency room patient and/or outpatient. Provide or assist with the initiation and maintenance of accurate concise outpatient records. Communicate in a timely fashion pertinent assessment to the providers and carry out orders. Other duties as assigned.</p>

Should have 2-3 years of progressively responsible experience in hospital nursing. Experience and skills in ER is highly recommended.
