<b>Position Summary:</b>	<p><b>Environmental Services Tech</b> Responsible for maintaining cleanliness, aiding in the prevention of cross contamination, controlling bacteria and odor, and sustaining an acceptable aseptic condition.</p> <p><b>Laundry Tech</b> Assists with the cleaning, sanitizing, storage, and stocking of hospital linens by providing support to other laundry staff as well as the nursing and surgery departments as needed. This position will also float to Maintenance as needed.</p>				
<b>Essential Job Duties:</b>	<p><b>Environmental Services Tech</b> Perform basic cleaning and servicing of all hospital areas. This will be demonstrated by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mopping and/or vacuuming of floors.</li> <li>• Cleaning of all occupied patient rooms daily.</li> <li>• Dusting of horizontal and vertical surfaces.</li> <li>• Window and glass cleaning.</li> <li>• Cleaning of bathroom fixtures, including pipes under fixtures.</li> <li>• Working independently or with other staff, depending on the nature of the assignment.</li> <li>• Communicating effectively with other employees and customers in performing the required duties.</li> </ul> <p><b>Laundry Tech</b> Will collect dirty laundry at start of shift, separate laundry to put in washing machines, and fold linens. Also responsible for washing/folding in-house patient clothing as needed. Can also be responsible for washing providers' and surgery staff's clothing, scrubs, linens, and bedding as needed. This position requires operating laundry washer and dryers by loading and unloading laundry and by using proper settings appropriately. It also requires working with contaminated laundry using universal precautions, understanding departmental emergency plans, using equipment properly, and recognizing and reporting unsafe conditions. Attend all team and department meetings and participate with positive input and discussion of goal setting, task planning, and job evaluation. Other duties as assigned.</p>
