Perform physical exams and patient observations. • Create patient care plans and contribute to existing ones. Detect changes in patients' health and modify treatment plans as needed. • Monitor and operate medical equipment. • Focus on health promotion, disease prevention, and health education and counseling. • Order, conduct, supervise, analyze, and interpret diagnostic and laboratory tests. • Administer medicine and other treatments. Prescribe pharmacological agents and non-pharmacologic therapies. • Consult with other healthcare professionals and refer the patient to specialty care clinics as needed. • Help patients make better lifestyle and health choices. • Train and consult patients and their families to manage and prevent illness and injury. 				
Qualifications:	NPs possess a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) or higher. PAs must be Certified and have a Bachelor or Master of Science (BS/MS) or higher. Minimum of five years' experience in a medical setting is required. Must have a current and valid Washington State Nurse Practitioner's license or Physician Assistant-C license. Basic computer and equipment knowledge and operation is required. Must use an EMR (Electronic Medical Record) for charting and documenting. Capable of using medical equipment and supplies in the clinical setting. Current BLS certification is required.
