Detect changes in patients' health and modify treatment plans as needed. • Focus on health promotion, disease prevention, education, and counseling. • Order, conduct, supervise, analyze, and interpret diagnostic and laboratory tests. • Administer medicine and other treatments. Prescribe pharmacological agents and non-pharmacologic therapies. • Consult with other healthcare professionals and refer the patient to specialty care clinics as needed. • Help patients make better lifestyle and health choices. • Train and consult patients and their families to manage and prevent illness and injury.

Must have a current and valid Washington State license and an active DEA. Basic computer and equipment knowledge and operation is required. Must use an EMR (Electronic Medical Record) for charting and documenting. Current BLS certification is required. Spanish bilingual is preferred, but not required.
