Position Summary:	General surgery is an eclectic mix of surgical procedures. General surgeons perform operations involving the endocrine system, gastrointestinal tract, liver, colon, and other major parts of the human body. As a general surgeon, some of the procedures you'll perform include appendix or gallbladder removals, colonoscopies, thyroidectomies, and bariatric surgeries. Some of these surgeries are minimally invasive and are performed using laparoscopic methods. Others, such as organ removal, can be very invasive.				
Essential Job Duties:	The General Surgeon sees patients daily, either in their office to diagnose illnesses and discuss surgical treatments, in the surgical suite of the hospital to perform necessary operations, or in their clinic or at the hospital to see how patients are recovering. They are responsible for providing a pleasant and mindful bedside manner for patients. The surgeon is responsible for the preoperative diagnosis of the patient, for performing the operation, and for providing the patient with postoperative surgical care and treatment. The surgeon may give specific instruction to clinical staff (ARNPs/PAs, RNs, LPNs, Surgical Techs, MAs, NA-C, office staff) regarding the care and treatment for their patients. The surgeon is the leader of the surgical team, so must maintain composure and be ready to manage any crisis that may arise. The General Surgeon manages postoperative recovery and follow-up care. Call time may be required for agreed upon shifts/dates or as needed. The surgeon may be responsible for an on-call schedule for after-hour emergencies, if applicable. Emergency settings may require performing urgent, life-saving operations for traumas or other critical situations. Responsible for updating patient charting as needed. The General Surgeon is responsible to and is a member of the hospital's Medical Staff.

Excellent judgment and decision making, critical thinking, problem solving, science background, service minded, time management, leadership, coordination, and surgical skills. Current BLS.
