Position Summary:	The Post Anesthesia Recovery (PAR) Nurse renders quality nursing care by providing intensive observation and assistance of the patient recovering from an operative procedure for which an anesthesia agent is required. This covers the period of time from patient admission to PACU through transfer and acceptance of responsibility of the patient by general or special unit licensed staff.				
Essential Job Duties:	Demonstrates clinical competence in recovering the surgical patient receiving anesthesia following established PAR policies and procedures. Assesses and provides for patient needs of daily living, privacy, and safe environment. Assesses symptoms and changes in patient's condition and responds appropriately. Carries out providers' orders accurately, seeking clarification when necessary. Administers medication and completes treatments accurately and timely. Practices medical/surgical asepsis. Maintains a well-stocked and aseptic department by cleaning equipment and replacing supplies and medications used before leaving the unit daily. Makes pre-operative patient visits whenever practical. Makes on-going documentation of recovery progression on recovery room form. Communicates pertinent information to other members of the health care team by giving a concise report that includes pertinent events of operating room and recovery room. Maintains confidentiality of patient, tactful and diplomatic in contacts with patient, family members, public, providers and co-workers. Assists in instruction and training of additional staff in PAR when requested by OR Supervisor. Assists in other nursing areas when unoccupied in PAR, if requested by Charge Nurse, OR Supervisor or CNO. Must attend continuing education workshops and seminars as required to maintain an acceptable level of competency in the department. Must be available to attend monthly departmental meetings when scheduled. Maintains a professional and courteous manner in interpersonal and interdepartmental relationships. Performs other related duties as assigned.
