Position Summary:	The Facility Engineer helps support the environment of care for patients, visitors, and hospital staff, in a safe and orderly manner. Performs skilled (journey level) maintenance, repair, and construction duties in one or more trades. May serve as a technical expert in a specialty field and lead the work of others. Typically, skilled work in the following areas: electrical, mechanics, plumbing, ventilation, carpentry, refrigeration, etc. Provides services within the Environmental Services and Laundry areas, as needed.				
Essential Job Duties:	Assists the Facility Station Engineer as needed. Examples would include, but are not limited to: Plumbing, engine powered equipment, locks and keys, hospital & departmental equipment, hospital beds, snow removal, security, painting, and renovation tasks, etc. Must be flexible and willing to work different shifts, rotations and call in as needed, and capable of meeting under pressure timelines with no direct supervision. The Facility Engineer is competent to complete the day-to-day Facility Station Engineer's projects, duties, and tasks when unavailable or off-site. Perform preventive maintenance on scheduled basis on assigned equipment for compliance. Handle all work orders received by Maintenance and other duty assignments in a professional manner. Perform safety checks and recommend a course of action. Assist with security situations as needed. Relieve or assist other service departments in the discharge of their duties. Other duties as assigned.				
Qualifications:	High School Diploma or equivalent is required. Training with a journey status as a trade worker, or completion of a recognized apprenticeship is preferred. A minimum work experience of 4 years is preferred. HVAC, mechanical and/or electrical skills are highly preferred. Organizational skills, interpersonal skills, good customer services skills and being team-oriented are expected. Cross training within the Environmental Services and Laundry areas will be required. Candidate must have valid WA state driver's license. Must be able to communicate (read and write) in English.
