Support CPSI/TruBridge operational environments and associated healthcare infrastructure systems. Perform advanced troubleshooting and root-cause analysis related to infrastructure, networking, cloud systems, remote access, and operational healthcare systems. Coordinate infrastructure upgrades, maintenance windows, modernization initiatives, and disaster recovery activities. Support cybersecurity initiatives including patch management, endpoint protection, MFA support, backup validation, vulnerability remediation, and risk mitigation efforts. Support lifecycle management and technical debt reduction initiatives. Conduct proactive operational walk-throughs and identify infrastructure risks, operational concerns, and improvement opportunities. Develop and maintain technical documentation, infrastructure diagrams, operational procedures, and asset tracking.
